



2024 Membership Information



Reminders

As a reminder, pigs must be entered in the name of the MYSPOC member that wishes to accumulate points from the exhibition of that animal, and must be shown by that member. MYSPOC members must exhibit their own pigs to receive points. The only exception is if the member has more than one pig showing at the same time, then a sibling/member may show the pig for the original member.

If a member is caught in violation one time, they will lose ALL points for that day. If they are found in violation two times, they will forfeit points for the entire year.

To be eligible this year, all pigs must be farrowed after November 1, 2023. **Crossbred pigs will NOT have an age or weight requirement this year.**

Points Eligibility

This year, there are 20 shows with 16 showmanship events. **For 2024, members will be able to count points from their 12 highest shows, and their 10 highest showmanship events.**

Purebred Papers

Purebred papers must be faxed/e-mailed to the MPA office NO LATER THAN May 15. **If no papers are returned, member will lose all points for that animal.** E-mail them to diane@mopork.com.

New: Membership Numbers

This year, members will receive an individual membership number for the Circuit. This number should be used at all shows to assist with identification purposes. It will be emailed to the address you list on the back of this form, and will come from the Missouri Pork Association office. If you do NOT have a number, contact the office immediately to be sure we have received your membership. If paying at a show, you will be contacted within five days with your number.

Swine Exhibition Requirement Changes for 2025

The Missouri Department of Agriculture has announced changes to animal health requirements for beef and swine exhibitors at Missouri fairs and exhibitions. Recently, these new regulations were postponed, and will now take effect in February of 2025. At that time, all pigs will be required to have current CVI papers AND have proper animal identification (an Animal Identification Number (AIN) tag or National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES) tag). Again, these changes are not in effect for this year. However, it is highly recommended that parents and youth learn about these changes now to be prepared for 2025.

Awards & Prizes

Final results will be announced at an awards ceremony August 7 at the Missouri State Fair.

Barrows and Gilts by Breed

Prizes to be awarded to the top five finishers in each breed for both market barrows and breeding gilts.

Overall Exhibitors

Prizes to be awarded to the top ten exhibitors in both overall barrow and overall gilt categories.

Showmanship

Prizes to be awarded to the top five finishers in each age division. The divisions are as follows:

- Novice – ages 7 and under
- Junior – ages 8 to 11
- Intermediate – ages 12 to 15
- Senior – ages 16 to 21

The Circuit will also award an Overall Exhibitor Award, Premier Exhibitor of the Year, Rookie of the Year and Top Show of the Year.
